## **PSD (Past State Deputy) Charles Riesbeck Award**

Looking at councils across the entire state of Ohio, this award is given to the council with the highest membership growth within a fraternal year. In 2022-2023, Elder Council added 41 new members—307 percent of the council's goal of 13. Andrew Nuckols, Ohio State growth director, presented the award to the council on August 15 during the rosary social.



#### **Star Council Award**

The Star Council Award is the Knights of Columbus' top award for local councils and recognizes overall excellence in the areas of membership, promotion of fraternal insurance benefits, sponsorship of faith formation programs, and service-oriented activities.

Of the more than 16,000 councils worldwide, only 2,005 (12.5 percent) earned this honor in the 2022-2023 FY. Due to Elder Council's increase in new members by 300+ percent of goal, this award was a Triple Star!
